

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

- In accordance with good environmental practice, care will be taken in all stages of operations to ensure that the least possible damage is done to the environment around the site by protecting trees, wildlife, and wildflowers and preventing unnecessary pollution of the environment.
- In addition, care will be taken to protect the interests of persons who occupy premises in the vicinity and construction operations will be carried out with the least possible disruption to the lives of the occupiers and other persons.
- The following matters will be given consideration during operations carried out with the least damage to the environment and the maintenance of aspects of local natural beauty.
 - ✓ Where necessary, protection will be erected around trees and areas where wildflowers are growing.
 - ✓ Care will be taken to ensure that existing water courses and ponds are not polluted, dirtied or obstructed during the construction period.
 - ✓ The burning of rubbish on site will not be permitted at any time.
 - ✓ Diesel and fuel storage tanks will be adequately protected with bund walls.
 - ✓ Contaminated waste shall be disposed of responsibly
 - ✓ Noise pollution on site will be kept to the absolute minimum.
 - ✓ Maintain high standards of site housekeeping especially with respect to rubbish and the correct storage of materials and equipment.
